Standing quietly among the trees at the top end of a narrow, cobbled track leading off Calder House Lane, Garstang Meeting House was opened for worship in October 1829. Closed for renovations last summer, Garstang Friends (as Quakers are more correctly known) invite you to join them for the formal opening of the renovated Meeting house.

The day will include Journeymen Theatre's latest production, *The Bundle*. Commissioned by the Quaker Asylum Seekers and Refugee Network, *The Bundle* is The real life story of a Chechen woman who flees the persecution and violence of her society and immediate family to save both herself and her children. Here in the UK, she continues to negotiate the complex and harsh thickets of bureaucracy in order to attain refugee status.
